April Prayer Requests

1. Please pray that the Emadis (Rep. of Ireland) would receive news about their visas soon.
2. Pray for John Kortie (Native Americans, AZ) as he recovers from shoulder surgery. His arm will be immobilized in a sling for the next several weeks.
3. Pray for God's blessing on Baruch Maoz's (Israel) commentary on Romans, which is about to be published.
4. On Friday evening, Apr. 5, the church plant in Bouc Bel Air will hold an evangelistic meeting on the theme: *Can a good God exist in such a world of evil?* 2500 packets with a flyer about the conference, a gospel of John and a letter from the church have been distributed to homes in the 4 towns closest to the church.
