- 23 Pr. Obed Rupertus (Santiago, Chile) is away from his congregation for a few weeks to help his daughter in MD, whose husband has abandoned and is divorcing her, causing much anguish to the whole family, including the three young sons of the couple. Please pray for them, for the church in his absence, and for Claudio, who fills the pulpit in Obed's absence
- 24 The Emadis (Rep. of Ireland) give praise to God that they got their passports back! Please pray that they get a Visa before April ends.
- 25 USAF Chaplain S. asks for continued prayer for the Henderson family that the Lord would continue to strengthen their marriage, and also for the son of a co-worker who is recovering from surgery.
- 26 The Torreses (Mexico) ask prayer for Adrian and Mayra. Mayra has been attending their worship service for a year and recently professed faith in Christ. She has been praying for her husband, and on March 14 Adrian closed his store for the day and attended church for the first time. Please pray for salvation and growth for this couple.
- 27 The quarantine has been relaxed in Lima. Pray that this trend would continue and that the Secrests will be able to resume their ministry with the church plant and with a possible medical team in July.
- 28 Trevor Johnson reports that he is almost healed (physically) and ready to return to Asia. Please continue to pray for his physical and emotional health, as being so sick for 2+ years has taken its toll on him.
- 29 The Korties praise God that First Papago Baptist is studying through the 1689 on Wednesday evenings! They send thanks to those who contributed to providing the 1689's and also to those who donated for their piano to be tuned.

30 Praise God with the Baldwins that all students were able to meet in person for the module in March, with no one sick, and in spite of some voices (in the churches and government) demanding that the school be closed, and that they already have 3 new students registering for the new 2021 / 2022 school year.

- 1 Tim Wenger (Switzerland) requests prayer for an Easter outreach on the resurrection of Jesus that they will be doing in the church neighborhood, April 1–4.
- 2 Daniel Master's doctor's appointment went well. Please pray with him and the Masters (Argentina) as they now are waiting for results of new tests.
- 3 The Secrests plan was to return to Perú on the 31st of March. They will be staying temporarily at the Swiz mission guest house in Lima. Pray that they will be able to find a suitable apartment and be able to move in as quickly as possible.
- 4 The Favres ask prayer for the French Senate as they are talking about a new law restricting the freedom of the practice of religion and increasing the control of the State on churches. Pray that the Lord would give them wisdom to refuse this law proposed by the government.
- 5 Founders Press is poised to publish Baruch Maoz's commentary of Galatians. Pray that through it many will come to see the completeness of Christ work.
- 6 Give thanks with the Ryttersgaards for an ease in COVID-19 restrictions enabling the whole church (CRBC Barbados) to gather together again. Please pray that international air travel will open up sufficiently enough for Pastor Ryttersgaard to travel to Covenant Baptist Church, Toronto, in July and August to reunite with the church family there and give Pastor Chris Powell some support and refreshment.
- 7 Please pray for the Selphs in Atlanta as they need wisdom to know how much they should integrate into the life of their new church, which they are quite pleased with so far, without hindering their work of evangelism.
- 8 India is off of lockdown now. Please pray for Pastor SB as he is holding evangelist meetings a few times a week in rural Hindu villages.
- 9 The church in Carlos Paz, ARG (Jorge Molina) is being attacked and defamed by local charismatic pastors who instruct their people not to attend the Reformed Baptist Church there nor listen to its message. They accuse Pr. Molina of preaching a "false gospel," since he exposes their prosperity gospel with its healings and animism. Please pray regarding this situation.
- 10 The church in Santiago, Chile (Pr. Obed Rupertus) requests prayer for the 7 recently baptized, for Daniel and Luis, who have just begun seminary studies (Wm. Carey Seminary), for Claudio and Abel, who pursue their seminary classes after their workday ends, and for two young men who are leaving the drug world.
- 11 The Johnsons give praise for the 100+ children they have a hand in supporting who are being schooled in Papua in Christian schools. Each year several graduate and return to their remote villages to help their communities.
- 12 Pray for the people of Chuichu that the Korties visit every week. They long to see hearts softened to the Gospel and lives changed by it. They have had some good conversations lately but know that only God can bring redemption.
- 13 David Vaught asks that we please pray for a group of about 30 French gypsies in Arles who have been coming for weeks to a meeting each Wednesday afternoon where Michel Gabarri and David are preaching the gospel. Pray for conversions and that this preaching point become a church plant.
- 14 The Kilians have several ongoing opportunities to provide financially/physically for several Zambian families. Pray with them that the families will also be receptive to the gospel truth shared with them.
- 15 The Masters (Argentina) request prayer for the new group of interns that has come to serve with them.
- 16 Tim Wenger (Switzerland) is thankful for Marlyse's God-guided backbone surgery and the pain-free use of her arms, for the March 6 training that allowed the youth to go deeper into the book of Esther and grasp the levels of understanding when witnessing their faith, and for the March 13 wives' training that was a great encouragement.
- 17 The Torres (Mexico) report that they are planning to accept ten new members to their church (IBPG) in April. Please pray for these future members and also for wisdom and discernment as the church receives them..
- 18 Please pray for the Favres' church this weekend (France) as they have an informal talk with Valentin and Emilie Mazur concerning their internship with them this summer. Valentin will preach in the morning, and in the afternoon they will talk together. Pray that the Lord lead them in their decision.
- 19 Please pray for the Selph's Tuesday night Zoom Bible study. They have an encouraging group of ladies (6 to 8) that have been consistent through this whole year, and now they have the resurfacing of a neighbor who is again interested in participating, a man who owns an "Adult" club.
- 20 Given the attack by local charismatic pastors on Pr. Jorge Molina (Carlos Paz, ARG) and his congregation, the church is asking God to open the door for them to have a radio program for broadcasting God's Word into their community.
- 21 The Kilians request prayer for African Christian University. Zambia's economy is spiraling downward, and there is much financial fear. Pray God will supply resources for the university to be able to grow during this time and be able to continue to educate godly young people.
- 22 Baruch Maoz requests prayer as he is working on Bible notes to the Pslams — ancient poetic Hebrew is challenging!
