# AUGUST PRAYER REQUESTS

- 1 David Vaughn requests prayer for four young men in the church plant in Bouc Bel Air, France, who are preaching and taking care of leading and pastorally caring for the church during David Vaughn's furlough the month of August.
- 2 Pray for the successful sale of the Maoz's home in Israel, so that they can relocate to the U.S.
- 3 The Kilians (Zambia) request prayer for willing and qualified workers from within Zambia to be raised up to train students. The discipleship component to the education at African Christian University requires mature leadership to model and proclaim Christ.
- 4 The Emadis (Rep. of Ireland) need to vacate their home. Please pray that they will be able to find a new residence.
- 5 Please pray for GBC San Diego and the ministry of Pastor Sudarshan (India), as they have just learned of a piece of land in SE India that is available for sale. Pray the Lord would provide, if this is His will.
- 6 Please rejoice with the church in Carlos Paz, Argentina, that God has finally granted them a meeting place in the city where they can be joined by others whom God will bring to hear His Word.
