



- 23 Please pray for four men with whom Olivier Favre (France) has been having a Bible study twice a month for nearly year. Pray they will see the holiness of God and their sins and culpability in front of such a Glorious God.
- 24 Trevor Johnson (in the US, recovering from illness) has confirmed that he is on the "watchlist" for Indonesia and that getting a new visa is not likely. He is appealing; however he is also looking into other ministry locales. Although he is physically broken, he still wants to serve a remote area (non-malarial). Please pray for the Lord's leading.
- 25 Pastor Jorge Molina (Carlos Paz, Argentina) is thankful for our prayers and for God's goodness in keeping all the church well through the pandemic, even though many of them are elderly. They request our prayers that the government will soon restore their freedom to gather for worship as they so long to do.

MISSIONARY PRAYER GUIDE



"For the earth will be filled with the knowledge of the glory of the LORD as the waters cover the sea"

HABAKKUK 2:14

- 1 Please pray for the Johnsons' children. Their son, Noah (15), is starting military school this month, and his daughter, Alethea, is undergoing an adjustment seminar for missionary children. The whole family is back in the US to help the children adjust. Noah will stay in the US and board, while the family pursues returning to ministry.
- 2 After preaching three times for congregations in Israel via YouTube, Baruch Maoz has been asked to Zoom lessons beginning in this month. Pray for the Lord's blessings on this ministry.
- 3 Larry Secrest (Peru) asks that we pray for the return of his passport and the retrieval of his new resident visa. They hope to be returning to the States sometime in August for their Home Ministry Assignment.
- 4 The Baldwins (Serbia) request prayer for the seminary enrollment. They need at least 10 new students to start a cohort (study program) for 2020/2021. They have 5-6, but are praying for 15 as they know they always lose some students. Pray that if the Lord desires a new cohort for the freshman class that He will provide this for His school. Though it appears to be a difficult thing in the midst of peoples' inability to find work during the virus, the Lord always provides.
- 5 Please pray for the Selph's ministry in west Atlanta as they have weekly Bible study with a family of eight that the Lord has brought away from the Jehovah Witnesses. There is a sweet eagerness to study the Word of God each week. Please pray for their conversions.
- 6 Join with the Emadis (Rep. of Ireland) as they praise God that their visas have been renewed for another year. They will be allowed to apply for citizenship around April of 2021. If that is denied, they will have to leave the country. Pray that the Lord will be pleased to have His hand in this process.
- 7 Please continue to pray with the Ryttersgaards for a permanent meeting space for Covenant Reformed Baptist Church in Barbados, ideally that they will be able to purchase the land that their current building sits on.
- 8 USAF Chaplain S notes that military families are moving later in the summer than usual due to COVID-19. He asks that we pray that their transitions will be as smooth as possible. In addition, please pray for a SMSgt friend whose mother is battling rare cancer. Pray that she confesses Christ!

- 19 Please pray for God's continued blessing upon Bonnie Secrest (Peru) as she leads the ladies Bible study every Monday evening. The attendance has been growing with 7 or 8 on Zoom and about 24 listening in on Facebook. She hopes to finish James before they return to the States.
- 20 The Baldwins are praising God that He allowed them to make it back to Serbia in June, even though countries were closing down again. However, Serbia is experiencing a resurgence of COVID-19 and many people are losing jobs and are without any money to pay bills or buy food. Pray for the Baldwin's protection and for mercy and grace upon the Serbian people.

Pray that the Korties will be able to resume contact with them. They recently met two men in their yard doing some home maintenance.
