- 23 Please pray for the weekly evangelistic preaching meetings being held by the Reformed Baptist gypsy churches at which David Vaughn regularly preaches, in the city of Arles, France. Pray for conversions and that the group of about 25 people could become the basis for a church plant.
- 24 Please pray for the Selphs’ gospel ministry in West Atlanta. In particular, please pray for a lady named T, as she may have recently been converted to Christ out of a life of homosexuality.
- 25 Please pray for the Secretsts’ small group in Peru, which is now meeting in their home and is growing.
- 26 Rejoice with Tim Wenger (Switzerland) in the recent interest of some people to join the church. Pray for their continued growth.
- 27 The Johnsons (Papua) give praise that they have hired 2 new teachers and are building teacher housing in Fuau village.
- 28 Please pray with the church in Carlos Paz, Argentina, (Pr. Jorge Molina) that God will grant fruit from the gospel message they are sending out via the internet throughout the city.
- 29 The Favres (France) ask prayer for the 4th year of theological training in Morschwiller’s church. Pray that the Lord will use this last year of training to equip the church for His mission.
- 30 Please pray for A. and her daughter E. who have left Pentecostalism and begun attending the church plant led by David Vaughn in the South of France. A. says that she has become a convinced Calvinist but now realizes that she was never really converted and has not become a new creation in Christ! Pray that she would come to true faith. Pray also for her husband, a Pentecostal pastor, who is also moving away from his old theology toward a biblical position.

31 Pray for the political situation in Chile (Santiago: Obed Rupertus), which will hold national elections for president, senators, etc., on November 21. The evangelical church there, historically downplaying civic involvement such as voting, needs a revived grasp of the gospel, and needs to recognize its responsibility as citizens.

- 1 Give thanks with the Ryttersgaards for answers to prayer for their safe journey to Canada last month. Jon and his family tested negative for Covid 3 times and quarantined for 14 days as per Canadian restrictions. They are now free to move about the province to serve Covenant Baptist Church, Toronto, until their return to Barbados in September. Please pray that this trip will be fruitful.
- 2 Pray for Valentin Mazur (the Favres' new intern pastor in France) and Emilie, his wife, as they move from Belgium to Mulhouse this week. Pray that the Lord will give them His peace in this important change in their lives.
- 3 Please pray with the Kilians for the faculty, staff, and students at African Christian University. Many are ill, many have recovered, and some have gone to be with the Lord. Chali Chakonta (28) was the clerk of works at ACU and died recently from complications from Covid. Pray for his wife and son. Pray for endurance, courage, and sacrificial love as the Kilians seek to help those suffering.
- 4 Please pray with the Masters for the gospel to spread through the crisis in Cuba and for protection and wisdom for the pastors and seminary students.
- 5 Last month the Torreses (Mexico) worked alongside Building Tomorrow's Missions group (construction projects and evangelism). Thank the Lord for safe travels, and pray that God will glorify His name through conversions.
- 6 Please pray with the Selphs that the Lord will send to them just the right van that they can purchase in order to carry people to the worship services in West Atlanta. They have people wanting to go that need transportation.
- 7 Pray with the Wengers (Switzerland) for their children's and youth camps—for 8–16 year olds—August 9 to 13.
- 8 The Secrests (Peru) request prayer for the family of Pastor Daniel Maxi. He just lost his mother to Covid, and his younger brother is in ICU. His sister has also contracted the virus, and they are helping to care for her family. Pray for the church as they carry on in his absence.
- 9 Please pray with the Torreses (Mexico) for an evangelistic breakfast being held by the Women's Ministry this month. The women have all have invited guests to hear the gospel.
- 10 Please pray for USAF Chaplain G. as he shoulders responsibility for an AF-level task. Pray, too, for preaching/teaching opportunities.
- 11 The Kilians request prayer for Justina Nankamba, the wife of Brian, a co-laborer at African Christian University. She recently lost twins in utero and has been hospitalized for some time—she almost lost her life, too. Pray for both physical and emotional healing.
- 12 The Korties (Native Amer., AZ) request prayer for a dear brother from the village of Hickiwan, Allen Garcia, who suffers from chronic neuropathy. This can be quite debilitating to him at times, but he remains trusting in God's care for him. He and his wife, Delma, are also grieving the death of her sister.
- 13 Please pray for the Johnsons in their ministry of traveling the U.S. to report on the last 17 years of their ministry focused on Papua.
- 14 Pastor SB reports that they are rejoicing that some churches have reopened. However, the village people in some areas are not allowed to open churches, and the news of a third Covid wave has the people troubled. The second wave made the nation a graveyard with uncountable deaths of their people. Pray much for India.
- 15 Pastor Jorge Molina (Carlos Paz, Argentina) requests prayer for Hugo & Oscar, whom he's been discipling—that they'll become part of the church there.
- 16 The Emadis (Rep. of Ireland) praise God that they received a one-year visa renewal! Please pray for them as they continue to do a lot of marriage counselling.
- 17 Tim Wenger (Switzerland) praises the Lord for answers to prayer, and that He worked in the hearts of the 25 young people who were taught the Word of God by Stefan Zürcher, Jérémie Cavin, Tim, and others. Pray for their growth.
- 18 Due to restrictions in Chile, the church in Santiago (Pr. Obed Rupertus) has not been able to meet in person. They have been unable to get a meeting place since the regulations keep fluctuating. In spite of this hardship, they are thankful for new converts and a greater attendance in their Zoom meetings.
- 19 Pastor SB (India) asks prayer for the salvation of Srinivas, whose mother and sister are believers. Srinivas has been very hostile to Christ and the church. He recently started to construct a new home for their family. At the ground-breaking, he had priests perform religious rituals, after which he couldn't sleep and was possessed with demonic spirits. Srinivas called Pastor SB to ask for prayer. He has since been able to sleep. Please pray for Srinivas' salvation.
- 20 Jon Ryttersgaard asks for prayer for the church in Barbados while he is away ministering in Toronto, Canada. Jon will return to Barbados in September.
- 21 Give praise with the Masters (Argentina) that their son, Daniel, has a confirmed diagnosis and treatment plan that does not require surgery.
- 22 Pray with the Korties (Native Amer., AZ) for Santan Baptist Church. Their reservation has opened back up completely, and more folks are coming back to church now. The Korties continue to join them for prayer meeting every other Wednesday evening and really enjoy their fellowship.
