- 22 The Baldwins report that the virus forced the Baptist Theological School in Novi Sad to go completely online, which is less effective. There is a great need for interpersonal fellowship among students. They are thankful, though, that they were able to hire a “chaplain” for the school (a recent graduate of BTS) so that he can visit and foster close relationships with the students in the school. Please pray that they can be back together again as a school in March.
- 23 Please pray with the Secrests for the growth and development of the church plant in Lima, Peru. They are meeting and worshipping publicly which is a major step forward.
- 24 Pray for Zambia as nationwide elections are happening this year. If the government party in power shifts it often brings many changes to everything in society, including the rules around how a university may operate. Pray with the Kilians for African Christian University to continue to grow and establish a solid reputation for higher education from a biblical worldview.
- 25 Tim Wenger (Switzerland) requests prayer for a course he is teaching “Discovery of the Heart of Christianity” (based on Christianity explored) beginning January 26 (8 meetings, 1 per week).
- 26 Please uphold the church in Carlos Paz, ARG, as they seek to remain faithful to Christ and shine as lights in an increasingly godless society. They are joyful to be well and meeting together again.
- 27 Praise God with the Torreses (Mexico) for bringing continuous visitors to their Zoom meetings each week who are hearing the gospel. Two new families have expressed their intention to attend their meetings regularly.
- 28 Give thanks with the Ryttersgaards for unity among the brothers and sisters of Covenant Reformed Baptist Church of Barbados, and pray for preservation of that unity as they transition from one strange pandemic year to another, which likely holds just as much abnormality and potential for stress and strife!

- 29 Please pray for the Selphs in Atlanta as they carry on a street ministry of evangelism. Generally they meet with friendliness, but the human brokenness is palpable..
- 30 The Palombaros (Udine, Italy) ask that we pray for God to direct them in His will during COVID with the delicate situation of the church plant.
- 31 Baruch Maoz is in the process of working on the Bible study notes for the book of Daniel as well as reviewing editorial comment on Acts and Romans. Please remember him in prayer.  
  
Also pray for the the church La Maison de l’Evangile in Mulhouse, France as they have their annual business meeting. Pray with the Faves that they will have spirituals goals for this new year.

- 1 The Baldwins' son, Graham, was able to make it from college to Serbia in December and will be there at least until January. Another son, Aidan, is scheduled to arrive December 29th. They are praying that the country will not close and prevent him from coming. It has been a hard year in ministry for the Baldwins, and a hard year for Aidan alone in the U.S. Being there with them will be a great comfort to everyone. Please pray regarding these matters.
- 2 Pray that the Kilians (Zambia) would effectively minister to both the physical and spiritual needs of their local community.
- 3 The Korties (Native Amer., AZ) ask prayer for Donny from the village of Chuichu. He is in the hospital due to having his toes on one foot amputated (diabetes related). Pray that he will heal without complications and that he and his uncle Milton will be receptive to the Gospel.  
Also, Olivier Favre (France) asks we pray for the church La Maison de l'Évangile, as they are trying to find a new intern pastor.
- 4 The Secrests (Peru) ask our prayers for their continued contact and ministry with Providence Baptist Church in Lecanto, FL, as well as for their visits with other churches and friends in the area.
- 5 The Torreses (Mexico) report that in recent weeks they have started to see the economic impact of the pandemic affecting some of their church families with cutting hours and job layoffs. Please join them in praying for provision for these families and for their church to know how to love and support them.
- 6 Please pray for grace and wisdom for our missionaries in N. Africa, as they make a final decision on an agency to serve their sending church well in helping them navigate logistics, care, missionary mobilization, training resources, security, and other benefits on the field. Some recent discussion caused them to pause on who they thought they would join. They have many conversations planned in the coming days and weeks to make a decision.
- 7 Please pray for the Selphs' work in Atlanta as they carry on a weekly Zoom Bible study with 7–8 ladies. The ladies are very untaught but sweet. Some show evidence of the new birth.
- 8 The Ryttersgaards report that many Barbadians attend church at Christmastime. Please pray that God will have brought unbelievers to the Christmas Eve service of Covenant Reformed Baptist Church, and ultimately to Christ!
- 9 Ottavio Palombaro (Udine, Italy) asks that we pray for him, "since I became more aware of my weakness, that God will make me into the man of God, shepherd, and leader He wants me to be."
- 10 Join in praise to God with Trevor Johnson (Papua, on medical leave in the U.S.) that, after 2 years of misery, his extreme and chronic pain has ended after receiving RFA (Radiofrequency Ablation) for his neck and shoulder. He reports it is, "like a miracle!" Also, the Johnsons are praising God for several ministry-related answers to prayer: they hired new teacher, they now support 25 students in Danowage, 60+ students in Fuau, and teachers Andika, Nia, Albertina, and Rhesi. They have also been able to advance school fees for 17 students.
- 11 Pray for David Vaughn as he trains M\_\_\_\_\_ and J\_\_\_\_\_ who lead two gypsy churches that have gone from Pentecostalism to 1689 RB churches. Pray also for several gypsy men that David, M, and J are counseling who, having also come out of Pentecostalism, don't know if they were ever really converted, and are exercised over this.
- 12 The RB church in Carlos Paz, ARG is blessed with national pastor, Jorge Molina, who has persevered in shepherding the little flock and remains faithful in preaching the gospel. He longs for a co-worker as they seek to evangelize the neighborhood of their new meeting place. Please pray with him regarding this need.
- 13 Give thanks to God: Pr. Obed Rupertus (Santiago, CHE) is discipling many believers. 40 folks attended their recent service (Zoom and in-person). Also, the boss of 2 new believers who are sharing the gospel at work is commending them.
- 14 Pray for Baruch Maoz as he teaches an Israeli church via Zoom on the doctrine of God.
- 15 Tim Wenger (Switzerland) is thankful for the people who responded to the need to replace Marlyse in the children's Sunday School. They will have a training for the Sunday School teachers January 16th. Please continue to pray for Marlyse, who has a C6 disc protrusion.
- 16 Please pray for USAF Chaplain G's sons, Jameson and Jonathan, as they both face life transitions: Jameson as he graduates from college, and Jonathan as he seeks to enlist in the military. Please pray for them to love the Lord above all else.
- 17 The Masters (Argentina) are praying about the possibility of planting a new church in the city of Córdoba as the restrictions of COVID loosen. Please pray with them.
- 18 Our missionaries in N. Africa report that they are nearing 76% of their budget needed for support in order to return to the field. Pray for God's continued provision and increase of faithful partners to join them in on-going financial support. They are speaking at several churches and connecting with many individuals who could be potential partners. Ask God to move the hearts of His people for His work in North Africa to continue.
- 19 The Korties (Native Amer., AZ) give praise that as they traveled during the month of December, they were still able to stay in touch with the folks in AZ via phone. COVID cases increased and things shut down again, but they praise God for the doors that have recently opened to them. They are continuing Bible studies and praying with the folks even while on the road.
- 20 Pray that the RB church in Santiago, CHE (Obed Rupertus) will be faithful in the face of continued national violence, disorder, and opposition to the Gospel, and that they will have grace and maturity to demonstrate the difference between those who serve God and those who serve self.
- 21 Please pray for USAF Chaplain G. to act with wisdom and boldness for the sake of truth and righteousness in his current position of leadership.
