JULY PRAYER REQUESTS

- 1 Pray for the five people baptized at Beijing Baptist Church's annual retreat held in early June. Pray that they would remain strong in their faith, walk with Christ all their days, and be bold for the gospel.
- 2 Pray for a group of young people from Emmanuel Baptist Church, Coconut Creek, FL, who will be helping the Korties (Native Amer./AZ) with their ministry the beginning of July. Pray for fruit from their labors, and that God will continue to open doors of opportunity for the Korties to assist and encourage native pastors and churches on both the Tohono O'odham and Gila River reservations in AZ.
- 3 Baruch Maoz (Israel) seeks God's blessing on the course he is teaching: "How to Preach and Listen to Sermons."
- 4 Pastor Marty Hoffman and his son, Jonah, will travel to Peru on July 5th. Marty will be preaching in the Secrest's church in Lima on the 7th and will travel with a medical outreach team. Please pray for his ministry.
- 5 Please pray for the biblical and sports training courses, for young people 16 years old and up, held July 6-13 in Geneva.
