



- 22 Please pray for the Selphs in Atlanta as they continue their Tuesday night Zoom Bible study. There have been several struggling with conviction over their sinful lifestyles.
- 23 The Korties (Native Amer., AZ) ask that we continue to pray for Shawn in Chuichu. They have been able to have a couple of good conversations with him and have given him a Bible. Pray that he will read it, that the Korites can discuss it with him, and that God will give him a hunger and thirst for righteousness.
- 24 Tim Wenger (Switzerland) rejoices to know that God is building his church. Pray with him as he implores the Lord to help him be a good assistant shepherd to feed his flock.
- 25 Please join in prayer with the Vaughns for the Reformed Baptist Summer Camp in France, which is planned for July 26-30. About 130 people are registered, which is encouraging in light of the uncertainties caused by Covid. Please pray that this will be a time of great spiritual refreshing from the presence of the Lord and that the Spirit's converting power would be present in the evening evangelistic messages, especially among the children and young people.
- 26 Pray with the Wengers (Switzerland) for their summer camp, July 26-30 in France, and also the children's and youth camps—for 8-16 year olds—August 9 to 13.
- 27 Please pray with the Torreses (Mexico) for Maria Angeles. She recently lost her husband to Covid.
- 28 Argentine national pastor Jorge Molina and the church in Carlos Paz are using every means possible to keep Christ central in their daily lives and to encourage each other in their faith while they are not able to meet. Please pray for the Lord to provide a pastor or missionary to help Pastor Jorge in building up the work.

- 29 Due to growth that God has given, the church in Santiago, Chile, is now too large to gather where they had previously met. Pastor Obed Rupertus asks that we pray that God would lead them to an appropriate place to meet for worship. Since things have been closed down for so long, it will be crucial for them to find a place as things begin to open back up. Please ask God to intervene on their behalf.
- 30 Pray with the Kilians for African Christian University. They had to revert to e-learning platforms as Covid rages. By God's grace they continue on in the face of many obstacles.
- 31 Give praise with Baruch Maoz that the Supreme Court in Israel has ruled that the Legislature must treat churches like all non-for-profit bodies with regard to tax.

- 1 Please pray for safe and smooth travel for the Ryttersgaards as they fly from Barbados to Canada today.
- 2 Pray for the Bible study Olivier Favre (France) is doing with five non-Christian men at Protec (a factory where a deacon of the church is working). They had to stop for a long time because of Covid, and Olivier hopes that they will be able to start again in this month.
- 3 Tim Wenger (Switzerland) asks prayer for the youth Bible training—for young people over 16 years of age—which takes place from July 3–10 in Geneva. Pray that the Lord would transform lives for his glory.
- 4 Our friends with N. African Partnership arrived on June 23. They now need to pack up their former home in Twin Peaks and move to Orange City. They have a temporary place in Orange City as they look for permanent housing, start a new business, and pursue their business visas this summer. They have 90 days to get most of this done. Please pray for encouragement, dependence, and trust in the Lord for success in these tasks.
- 5 A new wave of Covid has hit the country of Argentina, and they are under very strict quarantine. Please pray with the Masters for the churches that are unable to meet, for those who are sick including some pastors, and the many who are struggling financially.
- 6 The Johnsons are now traveling to report at churches and raise funds for a dorm for students in Papua, Indonesia. Pray that this will be a fruitful time.
- 7 The Korties (Native Amer., AZ) report that the churches on the two reservations continue to be under Covid restrictions. More people are attending now, though, and that is encouraging. Pray for Pastors Jay Juan and Lee Miguel as they shepherd their flocks.
- 8 Pray for Bonnie Secrest's ladies meeting in Peru. She will be teaching on the first chapters of Hebrews. The group will meet via ZOOM, but in a few weeks the Secrests hope to have the group in their home as well as on ZOOM.
- 9 Please pray for the Selph's gospel labors in Atlanta as Bob writes new gospel leaflets to hand out every week on the streets.
- 10 Please pray for USAF Chaplain G. to have wisdom, discernment, and boldness as he works on the AF-wide "Spirituality/Spiritual Fitness" guide.
- 11 The Torreses (Mexico) ask that we pray for Adrian, Mayra, and Hefzy who recently professed faith in Christ and desire to be baptized. Pray that their church can confirm God's grace in their lives.
- 12 The Baldwins are receiving applications for the 2021/2022 school year at the Baptist Theological School, Novi Sad, Serbia. They need at least 10 students to start a new cohort, and are asking us to join with them to ask the Lord for 20 students!
- 13 Argentina has suffered a resurgence of Covid cases, so the little congregation in Carlos Paz, Argentina (Jorge Molina), after just a few weeks of meeting in person, has had to return to quarantine, which threatens to continue for some time yet. Please ask that the Lord would allow them to be back together soon to praise and worship Him together as they receive His Holy Word.
- 14 Pastor Obed Rupertus and the congregation in Santiago, Chile, praise God that despite 15 months of not being able to meet together, their spirits and love for each other and the Lord have not declined. God has graciously given growth in unity, grace, and numbers during this hardship. Thank you for your prayers for them!
- 15 Our brothers with N. African Partnership will join with a local brother to re-plant a local church in Orange City. They have not been meeting for some time, and they are unsure about many of the attendees' conversions. There are many complicating factors related to fear, jealousy, and health that have kept them from meeting. Pray for wisdom, openness, and receptivity to the Word of God as they desire to come together again and preach the word. Pray, too, for healing and reconciliation where relationships have been strained or broken.
- 16 The Kilians ask prayer for Zambia. They have a large increase in Covid cases (3rd wave) that is expected to last through the beginning of August. Pray for endurance, patience, and faith in the Healer as the hospitals are already above 100%. There is limited oxygen available, and the political situation is tenuous.
- 17 Pray for Baruch Maoz as he works on study notes on the Pslams—a real challenge due to the poetic use of language.
- 18 Please keep Covenant Reformed Baptist Church (Barbados) in prayer as Pastor Jon Ryttersgaard will be absent until the beginning of September.
- 19 The Johnsons give thanks that their efforts at opening schools in the interior of Papua, Indonesia, was recently featured in the national Indonesian newspaper, *Kompas*, which has 1.8 million readers a day.
- 20 Please pray with the Favres (France) for Valentin, pastoral intern, and Emilie Mazur as they are moving from Belgium to France. The Favres are praising the Lord that they found a little house for them close to the church in Morschwiller-le-Bas.
- 21 Pray with the Secrests for the political situation in Peru. It appears that the Marxist-Leninist, Pedro Castilo, has won but only by about .4%. This is being contested by the right-wing opposition party, which could lead to unrest.
