JUNE PRAYER REQUESTS

The area is jungle and their goal is to use the medical team to strengthen a church plant and share the gospel. The team will arrive on May 30th and leave on June 8th.
- 2 Due to Cheryl's ongoing lung health issues, Mark and Cheryl Hatfield from Beijing Baptist Church plan to transition permanently back to SC in early July. Pray for Mark & Cheryl to use this last month wisely in their ministry to internationals living in Beijing. God continues to bring them into contact with people who express spiritual hunger. Pray also for Beijing Baptist Church as the pastoral search committee seeks a new pastor.
