MISSIONARY PRAYER GUIDE



"For the earth will be filled with the
knowledge of the glory of the LORD
as the waters cover the sea"

HABAKKUK 2:14

- 24 The Secrests (Peru) request prayer for Daniel Maxi, the pastor of their church in Lima, Gracia Urbana Lima. Because of the economic downturn his salary at the bank has been reduced by 50%. Please pray that his needs (family of five) would be provided.
- 25 The Kilians request prayer for Zambia. Many are expected to be directly affected by COVID-19 over the next 3-6 months, but many more will be indirectly affected for years by economic devastation and food insecurity attributable to the global effects of the pandemic. Pray for the church to be a leading voice and clear testimony of Christ's love and mercy during this trying time.
- 26 Please pray for perseverance for two new families in the Reformed Baptist Church of Santiago, Chile. God has worked in their lives, both have requested baptism, and Pastor Obed is discipling them. Pray God continues the good work He has begun in them through these difficult weeks of quarantine.
- 27 Two specific needs for the church in Carlos Paz, Argentina, are for a missionary/co-worker with Pastor Jorge Molina and for them to be able to locate (and afford) an adequate meeting place where they can receive guests and see God give growth.
- 28 Please pray with Jon Ryttersgaard that CRBC Barbados would be able to secure a permanent meeting space, whether in their current location or elsewhere, that the Lord may open and close doors.
- 29 Pray with the Korites (Native Amer., AZ) that doors will reopen at the corrections facility and nursing home so that they can resume their ministries there.
- 30 Tim Wenger (Switzerland) asks us to pray for the church of Neuchâtel. A family with useful gifts for the church, who have six children, is going to move for professional reasons, it is a great loss that they ask the Lord in His grace to fill by several stable families.

- 1 The theological school in Novi Sad, Serbia is having their "online classes." The Baldwins praise the Lord that they already had videos recorded that the students could watch. Please pray that the Spirit will work in the students' hearts and change their lives with His truth.
- 2 The Korties (Native Amer., AZ) ask prayer for the pastors on both reservations as they make decisions on reopening their churches. Their congregations have not been able to meet via ZOOM or Facebook, and they are very ready to be back together. Pray that they will have the wisdom on moving forward. Both churches that the Korties attend most regularly are planning to resume services June 7.
- 3 Pray with the Masters (Argentina) that they will see fruit that remains from their virtual evangelism of their churches.
- 4 Baruch Maoz reports that he is writing on, "How to Understand the Bible" and asks that we please pray for him.
- 5 Please give thanks with the Ryttersgaards for Jonathan Alleyne, their first Bajan deacon at CRBC Barbados, scheduled to be ordained in June, God willing. Also, pray that God would raise up more pastors and deacons to help in the Lord's work there.
- 6 Pray for Trevor Johnson (Papua/recovering States side), as his health has relapsed. He is passing out often and is experiencing extreme pain and dry heaves. Doctors have said his central nervous system has been destroyed by parasites. He also contracted a lung infection in January that looks like possible COVID-19. He is in chronic pain/exhaustion.
- 7 The Favres (France) ask prayer for the wisdom needed in the organization of reopening their church for Sunday services following the COVID-19 closures.
- 8 USAF Chaplain S. requests prayer for the chaplains rotating in June. Pray that those returning home have blessed reunions with loved ones, and that those heading out will be encouraged and strengthened to the tasks before them.
- 9 Pastor Obed Rupertus in Santiago, Chile is very concerned and asks that we join in prayer for 11 year old Matias, whose father Gabriel went to be with the Lord after 8 yrs. fighting cancer (obviously most of Matias' life). Matias is suffering extreme panic attacks (sometimes 5x a day) that leave him mute and paralyzed. Please ask the Lord for wisdom and healing.
- 10 Please pray for the Selphs as they do food sharing and street evangelism on the west side of Atlanta.
- 11 Tim Wenger (Switzerland) indicates that June 14 could be the first Sunday their church should be able to meet together again. Pray that the Lord will lead this time of reunion and allow John 13:34-35 to be a reality. Pray especially for the elderly in the church who suffer from the confinement and pressure of a society that wants to "control" the situation.
- 12 David Vaughn (France) request prayer for seven non-Christians who attended a video-conference a couple of weeks ago on the topic: "What I believe: Is it Important?" Pray that the Spirit of God would cause God's Word to bear fruit in their lives convicting them of sin and drawing them to Christ. Pray also that they would respond to the invitation to be part of a six-week Discovering Christianity Bible study.
- 13 Pray for USAF Chaplain G. and his wife, Sharon, as they transition to Alabama for a new assignment. Pray for their sons, Jameson and Jonathan, to remain faithful to Christ, and for USAF Chaplain G. to have favor with his new leadership.
- 14 The Kilians returned to the US (May 19) primarily because Zambia is about to enter a phase of increased COVID-19 cases, peaking in July-Aug. Pray that Ben will be able to effectively prepare and teach classes from the States remotely during this period and that the family will adjust well to their new circumstances.
- 15 The Masters (Argentina) request prayer for those who have lost work because of the quarantine.
- 16 Continue to pray for Trevor Johnson's (Papua/recovering States side) 15-year-old son, Noah. Trevor and Teressa have determined it is best, due to Trevor's health and the difficulty of recent transitions, to bring Noah to the States to live with a pastor who also farms. Pray that the Lord will supply the funds for travel and the possible enrollment in a military school.
- 17 Larry and Bonnie Secrest have both been granted permanent resident status in Peru. However, Bonnie's document has been held up because of their inability to get a good fingerprint. Pray that this would be resolved that that they would both soon have their documents in hand.
- 18 National pastor, Jorge Molina, needs our prayers for strength and energy as he continues to pastor the little flock in Carlos Paz, Argentina. Several of them are ill and elderly. Pray God keeps them faithful in following Him through these days of isolation.
- 19 The Baldwins had purchased tickets to return home at the end of June, but their sending agency is not allowing anyone to travel until the restrictions are lowered. It is hard for them to move between borrowed houses without stability. Pray they can return home soon.
- 20 Pray for USAF Chaplain S. as he begins the final leg of his D-Min journey. In June he will begin the research and writing for his final Project Proposal. Pray that the Lord would grant focus and attention and that he would be a good steward of the things entrusted to him.
- 21 The Favres (France) ask that we continue to pray for the pastor of the large charismatic church where the COVID-19 greatly spread in Mulhouse. At the beginning of May he had a very encouraging sermon on "Fearing God."
- 22 Please remember Baruch Maoz in prayer as he is translating into Hebrew and editing introductions to the Prophets.
- 23 Please pray for the Selphs as they enter various homes in west Atlanta and hold gospel Bible studies with families.
