- 1 The Secretsts ask that we pray that the pandemic will subside in Peru, that they will be able to begin their small group ministry in June, and that Bonnie will be able to effectively teach the ladies Bible study.
- 2 Please pray for Valentin and Emilie Mazur who are looking for a house, as Valentin should start his internship with Olivier Fave in Mulhouse, France in August.
- 3 AW and JP covet your prayers as they struggle in their hearts with leaving the U.S. They are excited but at the same time sorrowful. They love their church and family in the states, but they also miss their brothers and sisters in Christ in North Africa and long to bring the Gospel to those who have yet to believe. Pray Philippians 4:11 for them.
- 4 A drunken man threw himself in front of Pr. Jorge Molina's (ARG) car one night recently, injuring himself and causing Jorge's car to be impounded. Please ask God to make Himself known to all concerned through this severe providence.
- 5 Please pray that God will grant the RB church in Santiago, Chile (Obed Rupertus) a good place for their services when restrictions are lifted. They have purchased 60 chairs and have the money to purchase tables as soon as God provides a location.
- 6 Please pray for the Selphs in Atlanta as they explore options to secure a different van to be used in their gospel work there. Transportation to God's worship is a key part of what they need to do
- 7 The Emadis (Rep. of Ireland) still do not have their residency. Please pray that their visas would be extended or that they would get their residency.
- 8 Please pray for the spiritual health of the USAF Chaplain G's boys, especially Jon.
- 9 Raul Torres (Mexico) requests prayer for their beloved Roberto Angeles (66 years old). Roberto has been intubated in critical condition for COVID. Also pray for his wife Maria.
