- 23 Pastor Obed Rupertus in Santiago, Chile is enjoying discipling a new believer, whose wife and mother have been sitting in on the sessions in their home. The three have been attending services regularly, and now the man's father has begun to sit in on discipleship classes. Please pray that God will continue His good work of saving souls in that home.
- 24 The Baldwins (Serbia) report that their graduates want to get a masters' degree so they can be national teachers at the school there. Please pray for wisdom and grace in helping them achieve this.
- 25 Pray for opportunities for the Kilian family (Zambia) to minister to new students at ACU. Many come from difficult backgrounds and have many struggles.
- 26 Continue to pray for the Korties (Native Amer., AZ) as they visit native churches to come alongside the pastors. They are blessed with the relationships that are being formed and excited to see the possibilities of ministering to these pastors and their churches..
- 27 Pray for Baruch Maoz as he is busy reviewing and responding to editorial comments on his translation of Acts and his book on church life, while also writing and translating Bible study notes on Joel and Amos.

- 1 Through contact made by Donny Martin in Barcelona, the Reformed Baptist church plant in Aix en Provence, France has recently come to develop a relationship with two churches from the gypsy community in France that have come out of Pentecostalism, embraced the Reformed Faith, and adopted the 1689 Confession. Today, the 3 churches will have a united worship service in Marseille. David Vaughn asks prayer that the Lord would work during this service and that this would be the first step in future collaboration.
- 2 Baruch and Bracha Maoz report that their belongings are packed and on their way to be shipped! Please pray for them as they deal with the ramifications of relocation.
- 3 March 5-16, the Masters (Argentina) will host 3 different groups, each with their own purpose. One will be doing construction at the seminary building, one doing English classes, and one checking out the work to see how they might partner with the ministry, and it all ends with a 9Marks conference. Please pray for all of the logistics and for both the visiting and home teams to see what God has for them. Pray that the Spanish speaking pastors that attend the conference would understand what is taught and apply it in their own ministries. Pray that the speakers would be true to the Word.
- 4 Please pray with the Ryttersgaards for Covenant Reformed Baptist Church of Barbados as they work through an important matter that is affecting the congregation.
- 5 Please pray for the Selphs in West Atlanta as they meet with numerous young couples wanting to receive counsel on marriage. Pray they can influence them for God.
- 6 Pray for Olivier and Denise Favre this weekend, as they will be near Paris teaching on the doctrines of grace in a church coming back from a very legalistic background.
- 7 The Johnsons (Papua) ask prayer for their family, especially their two oldest children Noah (14) and Alethea (12), who are having adjustment and schooling problems.
- 8 The hunt for an appropriate place for worship for the church in Santiago, Chile continues. Rentals are scarce with the huge influx of immigrants, and scams abound in that market. Please ask God to guide Pastor Obed Rupertus to just the right place.
- 9 Please pray for USAF Chaplain G and family as they prepare for huge transitions this upcoming summer. Pray for him & Sharon to make the best use of the time with their sons (Jameson, Jonathan), strengthening them in their walks with Christ, and for Sharon and him to make wise decisions regarding their future.
- 10 The Secrests are looking at apartments in another sector of Lima, Peru in order to be supportive of a work that needs help. Pray that the Lord would direct them in this decision. Pray, also, regarding their application for permanent resident visas. They applied in November and have not heard from the immigration authorities. Their present visa is now expired. Please pray that this might be resolved.
- 11 Tim Wenger (Switzerland) requests prayer for all the Bible teachers in Switzerland to remain faithful to what is written in the Word of God despite the addition to the Swiss Criminal Code recently accepted by the people to punish those who would publicly oppose other sexual orientation.
- 12 The Emadis (Rep. of Ireland) request prayer as they gather all the necessary documents to apply for their final visa renewal. Pray that all would go well.
- 13 David Vaughn will be in Ivory Coast, W. Africa March 13-23 teaching 40 pastors from several denominations. Ten of them will be key pastors from a denomination in the neighboring country of Burkina Faso who will be returning to give the same teaching to the other 170 pastors in their denomination. Pray that God's Word would be powerful and transforming to these men and that they would see their God and their calling in a new and deeper way.
- 14 The Kilians (Zambia) request prayer for the faculty and staff of ACU as they have just begun a new academic year. Pray for unity and wisdom for those ministering to students.
- 15 John Kortie (Native Amer., AZ) is encouraged that several men from the native churches plan to attend the men's conference at Cornerstone with him. Pastor Robert Elliot will be the speaker. Pray that these men will be encouraged in leadership and that it will be a blessing to their churches. Also, Bethanna is encouraged by the attendance of the ladies in Sells at the Bible study/crochet class. Pray that the ladies will learn how to dig into God's Word.
- 16 The next module at the Baptist Theological School in Novi Sad, Serbia, is in a month and there are a lot of burdens for the Baldwins to make this happen well. Pray they will be able to do what is needed.
- 17 USAF Chaplain S. asks for continued prayer for two families he is counseling: a husband and wife whose marriage is struggling, that they will find healing and reconciliation; a family that is raising teenagers and desires to continue to parent with the gospel.
- 18 Tim Wenger (Switzerland) thanks God for the opportunity of witnessing to faith in Jesus Christ through a Bible stand to be held in Neuchâtel tomorrow. Pray that many will be reached by the biblical texts explained.
- 19 USAF S. asks prayer for chaplains who are anticipating new assignments this summer, that they finish their current jobs well as they prepare to move.
- 20 Give thanks with Covenant Reformed Baptist Church of Barbados as the Lord has provided a candidate for the diaconate who they anticipate will be ordained in June, God willing barring any legitimate objections.
- 21 Please pray for the Selphs in West Atlanta as they hold a weekly Bible study with a couple they met while doing street evangelism. They are coming to church each week with their six children and neighbors across the street.
