- 20 The Favas (France) report that a week of evangelization with a team from the Brussel Bible school is currently planned for March 22–28, however it is uncertain whether or not the students will be able to come, due to Covid. Please pray for the Lord’s direction.
- 21 The Secrests ask that we pray for the new church and leadership team in Lima, Peru, that they would not be overcome with discouragement with the Covid-19 restrictions that have been placed upon the country.
- 22 Tim Wenger (Switzerland) is thankful for the God-given opportunity to train state-recognized experts and camp counselors while openly living their faith in the training. Let’s praise God together with him.
- 23 Pray for Pastor SB in India, that he will have boldness to preach the gospel in the face of growing opposition. Pray also for good health for his daughter Evengeline who just turned 1.
- 24 Prayer is requested for Pastor Jay Juan. The Korties (Native Amer., AZ) report that he is having some health issues right now and is undergoing testing. Also pray for both him and Pastor Lee Miguel as the churches on both reservations have re-opened.
- 25 Raul Torres requests prayer for their recent men’s Bible study in Mexico. Pray that the Lord will raise up faithful men from among them.
- 26 The Baldwins have two new families joining them in the ministry in Novi Sad, Serbia within a week of each other. - 1 The Korties (Native Amer., AZ) report that services at Archie Hendricks Nursing Facility resumed on February 25. They will be meeting via social media for a couple weeks until they are approved to meet in person again. They look forward with eager anticipation to seeing the folks again. Pray that this ministry will continue to remain open to the Korties.
- 2 Pray that the Lord would allow the Baldwins to have an in-person module in March at the Baptist Theological School in Novi Sad, Serbia, and that the teachers would be able to come. The momentum of the school and spiritual level of the students wanes when they are not physically present.
- 3 Please pray for the Emadis' residency application to be approved in a timely manner and that they will receive their passports back soon.
- 4 Pastor SB in India requests prayer for a fisherman brother in his church who has a spine problem. The brother is very poor and must feed his wife, two daughters, and son by fishing. The doctors have told him he needs to rest for several months. If he rests, he cannot feed his family. Pray that the Lord will meet their needs.
- 5 The Masters (Argentina) ask that we pray for Sam's mom (Virginia) who has some health concerns. Also, pray that they would have wisdom to know when to step in to help or not. Tim Wenger (Switzerland) requests prayer for a virtual Bible training for young people on March 6 in which B. Rickenbacher will be involved.
- 6 Please pray that the Lord would guide the Secrests in the timing of their return to Peru. They still have some loose ends to complete (passport, doctor visits, and packing). They also want to return to useful ministry, not to just experience another lockdown.
- 7 Baruch Maoz will soon finish the course on the doctrine of God that he is Zoom-teaching a church and other participants in Israel. Pray that the participants' view of God would impact their understanding of all of life.
- 8 Trevor Johnson (Papua, home on medical leave) asks that we pray for his healing from a complete physical collapse that he will be able to get back into Indonesia after being kicked out. Also pray that there will be sufficient funds to support the 82 grade school students and the 17 in higher education.
- 9 This month 7 will be baptized in the RB Church of Santiago, Chile. Pastor Obed Rupertus rejoices for this great blessing from God and requests prayer for a stable location as they hope to gather together again soon.
- 10 The Favres (France) request prayer for their church, La Maison de l'Evangile, as they are considering calling Valentin and Emilie Mazur (former students from Brussel Bible school) for a one-year pastoral internship. Pray that the Lord would give everyone a clear conviction of His will.
- 11 Please pray for the Selph's work in Atlanta, especially for the Saturday morning Bible study at the City of Refuge women's shelter. The City of Refuge has recently set up every-week childcare just so young mothers will be able to attend the Bible study. This is a tremendous improvement to the outreach there.
- 12 Argentine pastor Jorge Molina (Carlos Paz) requests prayer for a man he is been discipling. Javier wants to prepare himself to serve the Lord actively in his work, despite resistance from his family. Tim Wenger (Switzerland) requests prayer for a virtual conference on March 13 for elders and deacons and their spouses. Also pray for Marlyse, who is having surgery on March 16.
- 13 USAF Chaplain S. asks that we be in prayer for the White family as they work to strengthen their marriage.
- 14 The Torreses ask prayer for Diana, who has faithfully attended the church in Juarez, Mexico and recently started experiencing severe back pain. Pray that her chiropractor will be able to figure out what is causing the pain.
- 15 Please pray with the Ryttersgaards for wisdom for the leadership of CRBC Barbados in navigating COVID-19 issues, rules, and regulations in a Biblically faithful way.
