

22. The Emadis (Rep. of Ireland) request prayer for wisdom regarding a good location to plant a church.
23. Please pray for the Selphs as they teach the gospel at the City of Refuge homeless center. There is currently a group of about 20 ladies that are consistently eager to study the Word of God on Saturday mornings.
24. Pray for God's blessing on the publication of Baruch Maoz's (Hebrew) commentary on Romans.
25. Pray for pastor Sudarshan's (SE India) involvement in the ongoing pastoral training. He reports, "Friends of mine, Pastor Anil, and Pastor Ezra are taking classes. Pastor Ezra is preaching Pauline epistles and Pastor Anil is on Minor Prophets of Old Testament. I hope that the course will be completed by the end of this year."
26. Sam and Carita Masters (Argentina) request continued prayer for the health of their son.
27. The Ryttersgaards (Barbados) request prayer that the Lord would move in the heart of the owners of the land on which their church building sits, that the owners would be willing to sell the land to the church.
28. The Korties ask prayer that the people of both the Tohono and Akimel O'odham reservations will have a desire for Christ. There is a frustration with a lack of commitment from the people in ministry endeavors, but they know that only God can draw these people to a real relationship with Himself. Pray that the Korties will be faithful in bringing the Word with every opportunity given.
29. The Selphs request prayer for the young people to whom they minister, that they would have a true understanding of the gospel of salvation and that those to whom they minister would remain faithful.

30. The Emadis (Rep. of Ireland) request prayer for affordable housing, as well as the ability to make inroads with the people in their area. Most families have roots in the same area for generations, therefore the Emadis are seen as outsiders.
31. Pastor Sudarshan (SE India) asks for prayer for Ramana who is being persecuted in this way: "A recently converted brother from our Church is Mr. Ramana. He was saved and became our church member for one year. He was a (Hindu) temple worshipper previously; he used to sing religious songs, chants and an active member in the temple. After he started coming to the church, the villagers are very angry with me and Ramana also. But he said to them, right from my birth, I used to worship temple gods in vain, but Jesus gave peace to my heart and he is only true God. So, the committee of the temple, with the help of the village chiefs, trying very hard to bring Ramana back to idol worship and they are planning to excommunicate him and his family from the village. It will be a great trouble for him. Now the villagers stopped giving him anything from drinking water to firewood. Please pray for him."

3. The Emadis (Rep. of Ireland) request prayer regarding the renewal of their visas, as they still have not heard anything.
