MISSIONARY PRAYER GUIDE



"For the earth will be filled with the knowledge of the glory of the LORD as the waters cover the sea"

HABAKKUK 2:14

- 1 Pray for the Secrests (Peru) as they are presently in the U.S. trying the recoup and get some rest. Pray, too, for comfort for Bonnie, as her 95-year-old mother recently passed away.
- 2 The Dean of Students at ACU, a close friend of the Kilians (Zambia), just found out his wife has cancer and will need to begin treatment immediately. Entreat God to physically heal and meet the spiritual and great financial needs of this precious family.
- 3 Sam Masters (Argentina) requests prayer for pastor Fabian Abregu. He rolled their pickup. He is fine, but now needs to fix the truck.
- 4 The Wells (Italy) request prayer for the smooth adjustment of their new interim pastor. He is a full-time missionary, who will oversee the Sunday worship while they continue to seek someone who can serve in the position long-term. Also pray that the Lord would send the right man to take over the church. They note that Italian is useful, but not required, as the preaching is often in English. Most of the people are fluent in English, and they use a translator and head-sets for those who prefer/need Italian.
- 5 In October both Pastor Obed Rupertus (Chile) and his wife, Maria Teresa, were ill. Please pray for strength as Obed not only pastors the church in Santiago, but also ministers with churches in Curacaví, Puerto Montt and Los Angeles, along with the radio ministry.
- 6 Pray for the Lackland AFB Chapel community. Although not assigned to the chapel, Chaplain Josh Stoley will be working with the assigned chaplain to revitalize the ministry.
- 7 The Johnsons give praise that although some health issues remain, Trevor has recovered enough that they have submitted documents to get their visa to return to Papua, Indonesia, about the end of January. Currently, they are in Thailand awaiting a visa renewal to return to Malaysia where he is under doctor's supervision. There is a chance the visa will get blocked. Pray they can return to Malaysia, and that Trevor's health will continue to improve.
- 8 John Kortie (Native Amer., AZ) will be providing pulpit fill for Pastor Jay Juan for the months of November and December. Please pray that these months at First Papago Baptist in Sells will prove restful for Pastor Juan and that John will bring the Word of God in an encouraging way to the people of the church.
- 9 Tim Wenger (Switzerland) asks prayer for the Reformed Baptist Churches conference taking place in Bulle today. The preaching will focus on a scriptural response to the Roman Catholic faith.
- 10 Olivier Favre (France) requests prayer for their church today as they evaluate the gifts and graces of a new man for the eldership of the church.

- 16 Both Pastor Jorge Molina (Argentina) and Pastor Obed Rupertus (Santiago, Chile) request prayer for wisdom for a larger meeting place as their present rental locations are too small. Pastor Molina has until the end of this month to find another location. Pastor Rupertus is praising God for the recent growth that created the need.
