## MISSIONARY PRAYER GUIDE

- 1 Please pray for the men preaching and leading services at Covenant Reformed Baptist Church of Barbados in Pastor Jon Ryttersgaard's absence, as Jon attends the Reformed Baptist Network General Assembly.
- 2 The Selphs request prayer for the Atlanta Gospel ministry. They had to recently switch Panera Bread restaurants as their supplier for bread stuffs. The restaurant used for 2 years recently closed their doors. However, the one on the campus of Georgia Tech University is now the weekly supplier. There are positives and negatives (humanly speaking) about the change. It is a wonderful way to get out among the people and share the Gospel and Christ's love on the westside of Atlanta.
- 3 The Secrests (Peru) will be visiting family, and their overseeing church in Lecanto, FL, October 4–31. Pray that it will be a time of rest and refreshment.
- 4 On October 5th, the Baptist Theological School will graduate its first class. Please pray with the Baldwins for this education to impact the Balkans through the students: Miro, Igor, Nenad, Neshia, Marija, Sasha, Ervin, Petar and Stefan.
- 5 Please continue to pray for Trevor Johnson's (Malaysia/Indonesia) health. Although it is improving, he still has stage 2 renal injury and they are trying to figure out why.
- 6 Pray that the Lord will help Olivier Favre (France) set the right priorities in the ministry as this autumn is very busy for him.
- 7 Please pray for Baruch Maoz (Israel) as he works to translate and edit the *Statement on Christology* for the Israeli public.
- 8 The Masters (Argentina) request prayer for the construction of their seminary building.
- 9 The Emadis (Rep. of Ireland) report that their visa/residency situation is ongoing and that their lawyer was not very confident about their residency prospects. However, God is in control. Please continue to pray regarding this.
- 10 The Korties (Native Amer., AZ) are praising the Lord that after several attempts to have a Bible study with Natasha, she finally came out to their house on September 15. They had a good discussion with her and she acknowledges her need of Jesus and wants to follow Him in obedience. She has been reading her Bible and praying on her own. Pray that this whole family will come to know Christ.
- 11 Tim Wenger (Switzerland) gives thanks for the prayers for the church bazaar on September 7 and asks that we pray for the ten people who came from the neighborhood (thirty people came from other areas).
- 12 The Reformed Baptist Church in Carlos Paz, Argentina (Jorge Molina) has been distributing literature in the city, and they request that we join them in asking the Holy Spirit to use these gospel messages to open hearts to receive God's grace.
- 13 Pastor Obed Rupertus in Santiago, Chile, and his wife have both been laid up and weakened with recent illness. Please ask the Lord to restore health and fervor for the ministry.
- 14 The Kilians are in the process of working with the Zambian government to receive accreditation for African Christian University academic programs. Please pray that they would work through the process with integrity and that accreditation would be achieved in a reasonable amount of time.
- 15 Please pray for the successful sale of Baruch and Bracha Maoz's house in Israel, so they can relocate to the U.S.
- 16 A new family (the Copleys) has joined the Baldwins in the work in the Balkans. The Copleys have a huge adjustment and will be going through a lot of trials. Please pray that they will be able to focus not on the difficulties, but rather on seeing God's grace, closeness, and purpose through it all.
- 17 Trevor Johnson requests pray for safety. There is violence in Papua. In his region, illegal gold miners have been attacked and killed and hundreds evacuated.
- 18 Pray for Olivier and Denise Favre as they spend the weekend of Oct. 19–20 teaching in a church in the Paris area on the doctrines of Grace.
- 19 Baruch Maoz (Israel) requests prayer for God's blessing on the distribution of his commentaries on Romans (Hebrew) and Galatians (English).
- 20 The Secrests (Peru) request prayer for their medical outreach as they plan for next year's campaigns.
- 21 Please pray for the counselling that both Ashley and Michael Emadi (Rep. of Ireland) are doing.
- 22 Please uphold Pastor Obed Rupertus (Santiago, Chile) in prayer as he disciples a man who's battling alcoholism. God has given some victory already; please pray that the Holy Spirit may bring permanent changes in his life.
- 23 Pray with the Korties (Native Amer., AZ) for an open door to come alongside native pastors with encouragement and discipleship.
