- 2 African Christian University begins the final term of the year today. Pray with the Kilians for the students as they grow in their understanding of a Christian worldview and how it relates to their chosen area of study. Pray for the faculty to have meaningful interactions beyond the classroom setting.
- 3 The Emadis (Rep. of Ireland) are praising God that they found a place to move to!
- 4 Kimberly Baldwin (Serbia) spent the month of August in the U.S. It was discovered that her mother has cancer, and they spent the time with doctors and surgeries/treatments. Please pray for her recovered health, and for wisdom for them to take the best courses of action regarding this.
- 5 The Wells (Italy) request prayer that the Lord would bring men into their church plant in Italy. They currently have a congregation which is 90% female.
- 6 The Ryttersgaards request prayer for God to draw to faith in Christ the 10-15 people who heard the gospel during CRBC Barbados' Evangelism Weekend on August 16-18.
- 7 Tim Wenger (Switzerland) requests prayer for a church bazaar in Neuchâtel today. The people in the neighborhood have been invited. Pray for opportunities to share the Gospel with interested persons.

- 17 Please pray for the Emadis (Rep. of Ireland) as they start a Grace Marriage ministry in the church to strengthen marriages.
- 18 The Baldwins (Serbia) are praising God that He has raised up 12+ students to start the new school year at BTS! With so few Christians in Serbia, it always seems daunting to get new students, but the Lord is faithful. Pray that the Baldwins could faithfully teach these students.
- 19 Baruch and Bracha Maoz (Israel) praise God for Rose's wedding — a very clear testimony to many unbelievers, who remarked on the content of the ceremony.
- 20 Pray with the Wells (Italy) that the Lord would help their congregation to heal from a recent church discipline issue in which one of their only men needed to be put out of the church, pending his repentance.
