MISSIONARY PRAYER GUIDE



"For the earth will be filled with the knowledge of the glory of the LORD as the waters cover the sea"

HABAKKUK 2:14

- 1 Please pray with the Baldwins for wisdom as they seek to determine whether to open classes at the Baptist Theological School in Serbia, how they will get local teachers, and for new students if the Lord desires.
- 2 Pray for the Secrests (Peru) as they get settled in Florida for their HMA (Home Ministry Assignment). They will be working closely with Providence Baptist Church in Lecanto, Florida but also hope to visit other churches, friends, and family. Also pray for their continued contact with their church plant in Lima. They are working through the constitution at this time and continue with their weekly meetings. This is all via Zoom.
- 3 Please pray with the Wells who report that on September 4th a brother associated with the RBNet, along with his wife, is joining them in Udine, Italy, to participate in the pastoral ministry. Pray for a smooth transition as they make the many necessary adjustments, and that the hearts of the congregation will be knit to their new pastor, and vice versa, from day one.
- 4 Pray for Olivier Favre (France) who will lead a wedding ceremony today for a young couple who have just left a sect. Pray that the gospel be proclaimed with clarity and that the Spirit of God will so work that families and friends of the couple will discover the grace of God in Jesus Christ and come to salvation.
- 5 Please pray for Pastor Obed Rupertus (Santiago, Chile) in Maryland all this month helping his daughter through a family crisis. Praise God that his strong discipling ministry with many congregants has continued via Zoom, and ask for God's help for the two men who are preaching in his absence and that the congregation will remain strong and unified.
- 6 Please pray for David Adams and the Poiema Spanish Publishing ministry as they participate in and help host online Biblical Counseling conferences this month with Dr. Jim Newheiser.
- 7 Please pray for the Emadis' children as they start school in the Rep. of Ireland.
- 8 Please pray for David Vaughn's teaching at the Belgian Bible Institute in Brussels. On Sept.8 and 22 he will be giving 8 hours of teaching on biblical piety. Among the subjects of these first 8 sessions will be The Thirst to Know God, The Fear of God, Self-Denial, The Call to a Holy Life, Contours of Christian Character, Contentment, and Union with Christ – the Foundation of Christian Piety.
- 9 The Johnsons (Papua, recovering in Missouri) give praise that their son, Noah, is adjusting to military school well and even started a Bible study. Please continue your prayers for Noah.
- 10 Pray for Baruch Maoz as he has finalized the drafts of Matthew and Mark, and is about to finalize the book of Luke, in his work of translating the New Testament into Hebrew.
- 11 A number from the church in Santiago, Chile, are still unemployed from the epidemic. We prayed in June for 11-yr-old Matias, who lost his dad. While he is recovering from the severe panic attacks, he still needs prayer for digestive problems.
- 12 Praise God with Pastor Jorge Molina and the congregation in Carlos Paz, Argentina, that God has protected them from the virus, which could so easily become fatal for their elderly and health-compromised saints. They are thankful to have been able to share Christ's love and the gospel with many needy neighbors and friends.
- 13 Please pray with the Ryttersgaards for the recovery and maintenance of zeal among members of Covenant Reformed Baptist Church of Barbados. As others have been experiencing, they also have experienced a drifting and deteriorating effect on the vitality of their spiritual lives as a result of the COVID-19 disruption to healthy routines like church attendance.
- 14 Please pray for the Selph's every-Saturday Bible study at the City of Refuge in Atlanta. There have been cases of COVID-19, and there has been a transition with some ladies and children leaving and a good number of others coming in.
- 15 Please pray for the USAF Chaplain G. and family as they continue to settle in Montgomery, AL. Pray that they will have opportunities to communicate the gospel in the days and months ahead.
- 16 Pray for the chaplain teams that have been deployed for COVID-19 response that they can bring the peace of the gospel to those on the front lines of the pandemic. Please pray specifically for USAF Chaplain S. as he continues to counsel a Christian couple who is facing divorce and separation. Pray that the Lord would heal their broken marriage.
- 17 Please pray for wisdom for the Kilian family as they make decisions regarding the timing of their return to Zambia. The COVID-19 cases are continuing to rise in Zambia and are expected to peak in October. In addition, pray for ACU administration and faculty facing the challenges of resuming classes in September amid increasing COVID-19 cases.
- 18 God has been opening up more opportunities for the Korties (Native Amer., AZ) in Chuichu for getting to know folks. They are visiting 7 homes in this village on Wednesday mornings and Sunday evenings now. Pray that folks will be receptive to the Gospel.
- 19 Tim Wenger (Switzerland) rejoices in the 4 baptisms planned for September 20th and asks for prayers that this will be a powerful witness for non-believers and a great encouragement for the church.
- 20 Olivier Favre requests prayer for the church, La Maison de l'Evangile, in Mulhouse, France as they have their business meeting today. They plan to elect a new elder and make several decisions regarding their future. Pray for unity and a clear vision of the Lord's glory and of their mission in this world.
- 21 Please pray for wisdom for the Emadis (Rep. of Ireland) as they have two very difficult counselling cases.
- 22 Pray for Baruch Maoz as he teaches a church Bible class in Israel via Zoom and seeks to focus the congregants on God rather than on incidentals.
